STATE REQUIREMENT

FOR BUSINESSES & MULTIFAMILY DWELLINGS INCLUDING GOVERNMENT OFFICES & SCHOOLS



California Assembly Bill (AB) 341 now requires certain businesses and multifamily dwellings to recycle. This recycling effort targets single-stream recycling where cardboard, paper, bottles and cans are mixed together.

Businesses subject to the law:

- Businesses, nonprofits, strip malls, government offices & schools that generate 4 cubic yards or more of garbage per week.
- Multifamily complexes with 5 units or more.

Recycle to save money!

Save money by reducing your garbage and increasing your recycling. The cost for disposal services is based on your level of garbage service. The more material recycled, the less you pay in disposal.

What you can do:

- Enter into a service agreement with your franchised hauler or other commercial recycler (turn over page to help you get started); and/or
- Self-haul recyclables to a drop-off recycling center.

Local jurisdictions have contracts with franchised garbage companies to provide service for collection of garbage, recycling and yard debris for residences and businesses. Note that any hauler can pick up recyclable materials as long as it is free of garbage and no fee is charged. For collection of garbage and other franchised materials, you are required to use the franchised garbage company for your area.
