

# Prevent future fires - Rid your home of toxic and flammable materials.

## Here's how:

The North Bay Fires have made us all aware of the hazardous materials in our homes. Rid your home of flammables and toxics at **three FREE Fire Prevention Community Toxics Collections**. The Sonoma County Waste Management Agency has added three collection events to assist Sonoma County residents in clearing out their homes and garages of unwanted household hazardous waste.

- **Santa Rosa Veterans Memorial Hall: November 18, 8:30am - 3:30pm**  
*1351 Maple Avenue*
- **Cloverdale Depot: November 19, 8:30am - 3:30pm**  
*501 Asti Road*
- **Sonoma Valley Veterans Memorial Hall: December 3, 8:30am - 3:30pm**  
*126 First Street West*

This event is for **RESIDENTS ONLY**, no businesses.  
Community Toxics Collections are  
**NOT** for burned properties and will **NOT** accept burned material.

*All homes damaged by fires are to be serviced through official debris cleanups. Information can be found at [sonomacountyrecovers.org](http://sonomacountyrecovers.org)*

**LIMIT: A maximum of 15 gallons of liquid (with a maximum of 5 gallons per container) or 125 pounds of solid material allowed per vehicle.**

**NOTE: Packing and Transportation of Hazards:** Never mix chemicals • Place in sealed containers in the trunk, packed to prevent spills • Syringes/needles must be in a sealed and labeled approved container.

*Examples of Household Hazardous Waste: paint, batteries, fluorescent lamps, cleaners, solvents, pool chemicals, poisons.*

**Not Accepted:** Electronics • Explosives or ammunition • Radioactive materials • Biological wastes (except syringes) • Controlled substances • Fire damaged material or ashes.
